1 Adoption of the minutes and of the agenda, Information given by the Chair

1.1 Minutes of the 30th Plenary meeting – adoption

2.2 Questionnaire on opening borders - discussion

Upon proposal by one of the EDPB members, the EDPB decided to give a mandate to the prepare a statement on some of the issues identified in the questionnaire related to the opening of borders. Two EDPB members agreed to assist the alead of the next plenary meeting.

2.3 Response letter to ENISA advisory group - discussion and adoption

The EDPB Secretariat presented the request received from ENISA asking the EDPB to appoint a main representative as well as an alternate representative to the ENISA Advisory Group.

The draft letter announces that an alternate representative will be appointed at a later stage.

The EDPB members adopted the letter unanimously.
